

As per Department of Immigration, All foreigners arriving Nepal via immigration office at the airport should submit the following documents/requirements in addition to the Visa related documents for On-arrival visa as per TMO (travel management order) of the council of ministers/dated 22 Sep'21:

Arriving Passenger to Nepal:

1. **CCMC Form Fill up:** Print copy of “International Traveler Online Arrival Form” obtained after online registration via www.ccmc.gov.np or https://ccmc.gov.np/arms/person_add_en.php
2. **Mandatory COVID-19 vaccine certificate containing a QR Code:** Completion of **14 days** from the **first dose** of Johnson & Johnson or the **second dose** of other vaccines recognized by Ministry of Health, Nepal.
3. **Mandatory RT-PCR test for COVID-19: RT-PCR negative certificate** from any Govt. Approved Laboratory with validity of **72 hours** from **sample collection to Departure** time.
4. All passengers at the airport upon arrival **must undergo Antigen test** at immigration point in Nepal.

Nota Bene:

- ❖ **No Vaccination or RT-PCR Testing** is required for minor **below 5 years**.
- ❖ **Vaccination is not mandatory** for children between **5-18 years** but subject to **RT-PCR negative test** & other procedures applicable to adults.
- ❖ **Unvaccinated** passengers are permitted to enter Nepal but subject to **10 days hotel quarantine** at their own cost.
- ❖ **Foreigners holding Diplomatic/Official passport or UN Laissez-Passer, Foreign employees working in UN agencies & other International Organizations** in Nepal & their family members are allowed to enter Nepal along with **document 1, 2, 3** mentioned above.
 - ✓ Such **Unvaccinated passenger may also enter but subject to 10 days mandatory quarantine** at the specified residence recommended by the respective mission.
- ❖ Non-residential Nepali (NRN's) or foreigner married to Nepali citizen including their family members are allowed to enter Nepal but subject to document 1, 2, 3 mentioned above.
- ❖ **All the foreigners except the above mentioned, should obtain a tourist entry visa** from the Nepali diplomatic missions abroad.
- ❖ **Senior citizens above 75 years & their caregivers, minor below 5 years & their parents with recommendation letter of the local level** are permitted to enter only if tested **Rapid Antigen Negative**.
- ❖ Covid-19 positive findings upon arrival must undergo **Institutional Quarantine at self-cost**.
- ❖ **Emergency on following grounds** are eligible to get Visa on Arrival at the Entry Points **only if tested antigen Negative upon arrival** along with recommendation letter of Local Level:
 - a) For attending funeral of their relatives, b) Chronic patient, disabled & accompanies,
 - c) Look after their patient into ICU or Ventilator etc.

Departing Passenger From Nepal: For travelling from Kathmandu, Nepal to Bangladesh, passengers must follow below procedures:

- **CCMC Form Fill up:** All the Passengers must fill up & submit Covid-19 Crisis management center's(CCMC) prescribed “International-Online Departure Form” through the given link: https://ccmc.gov.np/atms/person_add_atms_en.php
- **Mandatory RT-PCR test for COVID-19:** Passenger should carry **PCR negative certificate** from any Govt. Approved Laboratory with validity of **72 hours** from the **sample collection to Departure** time. (Children aged **below 10 years** are **exempted from COVID-19 PCR test**)
- Passengers **below 18 years old without full dose of vaccination** can travel **only with their family**.
- Each Passenger must complete a ‘**Health Declaration Form**’ before arrival to Dhaka.
- Irrespective of the COVID-19 vaccination, any passenger can enter into Bangladesh but will have to complete **14 days of strict Home Quarantine**.
