## **Immunization Categories:**

- Fully vaccinated individuals with a recognized vaccination by Ministry of Public Health.
  - **Double Dose**: [Pfizer/Biontech Vaccine (Comirnaty), Moderna Vaccine (Spikefax), AstraZeneca vaccines (Coveshield/Oxford/Vaxepheria)]
  - Single Dose: [Janssen/Johnson & Johnson Vaccine.]
- Conditionally approved vaccines: Sinopharm, Sinovac, Sputnik-V etc.

**N.B**: Travelers, fully vaccinated with conditionally approved vaccines must receive at least **01** additional dose of the approved Vaccines in the state of Kuwait.

## **Unvaccinated categories**:

- ❖ Individuals who didn't receive any of the vaccination doses or individuals partially vaccinated (1 dose out of 2 doses).
- ❖ Individuals who have fully received the vaccine but have not Complete 14 days from the first dose of Johnson & Johnson Vaccine or the second dose of vaccines recognized by Ministry of Public Health.
- Individuals who received conditionally recognized vaccines from the Ministry of Public Health- Kuwait.

Proof of Immunization: 1. Individuals vaccinated in Kuwait are to provide proof of immunization via Immune App /or Kuwait mobile ID apps upon arrival.

2. Individuals vaccinated outside Kuwait are to upload vaccination certificate on <a href="https://vaxcert.moh.gov.kw/SPCMS/PH/CVD\_19\_Vaccine\_External\_Registration.aspx">https://vaxcert.moh.gov.kw/SPCMS/PH/CVD\_19\_Vaccine\_External\_Registration.aspx</a> containing: a) Name as per passport, b) Vaccine type, c) Dates of doses, d) Vaccine Provider, e) QR code.

<sup>2\*.</sup> If an Immunized individual wishes to end quarantine, must obtain a negative PCR test within 7 days of starting quarantine.
