

Latest travel advisory to enter Singapore

1. It is mandatory for all passengers seeking to enter Singapore to submit their SGAC within 3 days before arrival in Singapore via <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard>.
2. A traveller must have completed his or her COVID-19 vaccination with a vaccine listed in the World Health Organization Emergency Use Listing (WHO-EUL) at least 14 days before entering Singapore.
3. The following passengers are not required to provide proof of having taken a PDT for COVID-19: (a) a child aged 2 years or below in that calendar year¹³; (b) a passenger who has been exempted by a relevant Singapore Government agency from the requirement of a PDT¹⁴; (c) a transfer or transit passenger who is not seeking entry into Singapore; (d) from 26 April 2022, 0001 hours (Singapore time), a fully vaccinated passenger or a child aged 12 years or below in that calendar year.
