

Mandatory requirements for travelling to Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

- 1) All passengers must take COVID-19 negative certificate within 48hrs from the time of departure. Children up to Eight (8) years of age are exempted.
- 2) All passengers need to register on Arrival Platform, check visa and vaccination status through - **MUQEEM** (<https://muqem.sa/#/vaccine-registration/home>)
- 3) New employment, visit, family visit visa holder must carry proper insurance paper.
- 4) TAWAKKALNA APP must be available in passenger's smartphone. Passenger must show Immune Status in this APP.
- 5) **Immune passengers** need not to be quarantined after arriving in to KSA. They must carry the proof of vaccination.

Passengers who have spent more than 08 (Eight) months from receiving the Second dose of the vaccine and have not received the activation dose (Booster-Third) are not considered Immune.

Vaccines approved by KSA authority to be recognized as Immune:

- a. 2 doses of Pfizer-BioNTech
- b. 2 doses of Oxford-AstraZeneca
- c. 2 doses of Moderna
- d. 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson's Janssen

In addition, travelers who have completed two doses of the following vaccines will be accepted: **i) Sinopharma ii) Sinovac**

On condition of that they have received an additional dose of one of the vaccines approved in the Kingdom mentioned above.

- 6) **Non-Immune Passengers** need to go through 03/05 days of Hotel Quarantine.
 - i) **03 Days Hotel Quarantine:** Non-Immune Passengers who have received Single dose of the vaccine inside KSA.
 - ii) **05 Days Hotel Quarantine:** All other Non-Immune Passengers other than mentioned above.
