

Bangladesh to India

1) Self Declaration Form to be filled from following link within 72 hours of flight departure:

<https://newdelhiairport.in/airsuvidha/apho-registration>

2) Upload vaccination Certificate in above link if fully vaccinated

Or

Upload RT/PCR Negative test report within 72 hours of flight departure if not fully vaccinated (From sample collection time to flight departure time)

3) Children below 5 years of age are exempted from RT/PCR Test Report

India to Bangladesh

1) Self Declaration Form to be filled from following link within 72 hours of flight departure:

<https://healthdeclaration.dghs.gov.bd>

2) RT/PCR Negative Test report is exempted if fully vaccinated

Or

RT/PCR Negative Test report within 72 hours of flight departure is required if not fully vaccinated (From sample collection time to flight departure time)

3) Children below 12 years of age are exempted from RT/PCRT Test Report

Above are general requirements for passengers travelling Bangladesh-India-Bangladesh. But passengers must check updated Travel Advisory for coming to India from the website: <https://www.mohfw.gov.in> as it changes time to time.
