

TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR ABUDHABI, UAE

Vaccination is not a condition of entry

A passenger no longer requires a PCR test to fly to Abu Dhabi if he's fully vaccinated or under 12 years or he/she holds a valid COVID-19 recovery certificate.

No quarantine on arrival

- Test on arrival not required.
- A passenger may take an optional PCR test after baggage collection at Abu Dhabi airport –this costs AED 40.

Traveling with children

- Children under 12 are exempted from testing and quarantine.
- Test on arrival not required.
- Children aged 06 or over must wear a face mask on board.

Transit Passenger

Traveler's transiting the UAE will need to have a negative COVID-19 PCR Test if a test is required at the final destination.

#Entry to Abu Dhabi if you're NOT fully vaccinated

If a passenger is not fully vaccinated, he/she must take a PCR test 48 hours within his/her flight to Abu Dhabi and it's optional for him to take a PCR test when he arrives at the airport. He/she may not be permitted to visit public places at Abu Dhabi if not fully vaccinated.
