

## Detailed Travel Advisory

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1. Passengers are not allowed to enter except the following Category -

- Nationals of Malaysia;
- Passengers with a diplomatic passport;
- Passengers with MyTravelPass (MTP) obtained at <https://mtp.imi.gov.my/myTravelPass/main> ;
- Students with a written approval from immigration applied at <https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/> ;
- Merchant seamen with an official letter from the company certified by Malaysian immigration and joining the ship no later than 24 hours from arrival.

Category of Passengers also Allowed to enter Malaysia:

- Malaysian
- Foreigners with permanent resident status
- Diplomat and dependents of foreign mission in Malaysia
- Expatriates and their dependents, including foreign maids to expatriates who are holding a valid long-term pass and/or has obtained pass approval application to enter Malaysia. The application made through MYEntry system in ESD: <https://esd.imi.gov.my/portal/>

2. Passengers must install '**MySejahtera app**' in their phone & complete the health declaration and **Prior Hotel Booking** at least one day before flight departure. Otherwise Malaysian Immigration will penalize Biman & Passengers will be send back to origin ( as Deportee ) from next .
3. Passengers must have a negative **COVID-19 RT-PCR** test taken at most **72 hours before departure** from the first embarkation point.
4. Passengers arriving from Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan or Sri Lanka must have a COVID-19 vaccination certificate showing that they were fully vaccinated (WHO approved Vaccine ) .
5. Passengers are subject to a COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at their own expense(Arround MYR.250 ) .
6. Passengers are subject to medical screening and quarantine for 7 or 10 days at the first point of entry at their own expense (Arround MYR.2500 for Govt. Service Charges & MYR.150 Hotel Fare Per Day Approx).  
- *This does not apply to passengers with an approval letter for home quarantine applied at <https://ecovid19.moh.gov.my/outbreak-portal-hqa/index> .* They must have a COVID-19 vaccination certificate showing that they were fully vaccinated and are subject to home isolation for 7 days.
7. Airline crew must have their names listed on the General Declaration.
8. Airline crew are subject to quarantine until their next flight and must install '**MySejahtera app**' in their phone.
9. The maximum transit time through Kuala Lumpur (KUL) changed from 48 hours to 24 hours.
10. Transfer from an international flight to a domestic flight is not allowed.  
- This does not apply to nationals of Malaysia traveling to Sabah and Sarawak. They must have approval from the State Government.
11. Passengers traveling to Sarawak must complete an "enterSarawak" form and an "eHealth Declaration Form" before departure at <https://sarawakdisastermc.com/>
