



Travel Advisory for Kathmandu, Nepal

Date: November 01, 2021

(All foreigners arriving Nepal via immigration office at the airport should submit the following documents/requirements in addition to the Visa related documents for On-arrival visa as per TMO (travel management order) of the council of ministers /dated 23OCT'21, New standards for passenger arriving to Nepal , CAAN/dated 29SEP'21 and Air Transportation Circular of CAAB /dated 23October'21.)

ARRIVING PASSENGER TO NEPAL:

	1. CCMC Registration Fill out “International Traveler Online Arrival Form” www.ccmc.gov.np	2. Mandatory COVID-19 vaccine certificate containing a QR Code. (Completion of 14 days from the first dose of Johnson & Johnson or the second dose of other vaccines recognized by Ministry of Health, Nepal.)	3. Mandatory RT-PCR test for COVID-19: (RT-PCR negative certificate. 72 hours from sample collection to Departure time.)	Antigen Test (Done free of cost after arrival at Trivhubon International Airport)	On Arrival Visa (Upon arrival fill-out online visa application from Nepal Embassy Website or from immigration kiosks at Trivhubon International Airport by passenger himself.) - **No Vaccination or RT-PCR Testing** is required for minor **below 5 years**.
- **Vaccination is not mandatory** for children between **5-18 years** but subject to **RT-PCR negative test** & other procedures applicable to adults.
- **Foreign diplomatic/Development partner agency’s officials along with family members/ Medical Professionals support the COVID-19 control measures /security personnel & employees of Govt of Nepal on their returning flight to Nepal as per official recommendation** only if tested **Antigen Negative** are subject to self/home quarantine of **10 days’ upon arrival** ;
- Nepali Nationals/Non-residential Nepali (NRN’s) or foreigner married to Nepali citizen including their family members are allowed to enter Nepal but subject to document **1, 2, 3** mentioned above.
- **Senior citizens above 75 years & their caregivers, minor below 5 years & their parents with recommendation letter of the local level** are permitted to enter only if tested Rapid **Antigen Negative**.
- **All the foreigners except double vaccinated, should obtain a tourist entry visa** from the Nepali diplomatic missions abroad.
- Covid-19 positive findings upon arrival must undergo **Institutional Quarantine at self-cost**.
- **Emergency on following grounds** are eligible to get Visa on Arrival at the Entry Points **only if tested antigen Negative upon arrival** along with recommendation letter of Local Level:
 - For attending funeral of their relatives,
 - Chronic patient, disabled & accompanies,
 - Look after their patient into ICU or Ventilator etc.

DEPARTING PASSENGER FROM NEPAL:

- All the Passengers must fill out “**International-Online Departure Form**” through the given link: https://ccmc.gov.np/atms/person_add_atms_en.php
- **Mandatory RT-PCR test for COVID-19:** Passenger should carry **PCR negative certificate** from any Govt. Approved Laboratory with validity of **48 hours** from the **sample collection to Departure time**. (Children aged **below 12 years** are exempted from **COVID-19 PCR test**)
- Passengers **below 18 years old without full dose of vaccination** can travel **only with their family**.
- Each Passenger must complete a ‘**Health Declaration Form**’ before arrival to Dhaka.
- Passengers without having full dose (single /double dose as applicable for full dose) can enter into Bangladesh but will have to complete **14 days of strict Home Quarantine**.
- **Transit passengers are allowed in accordance with destination country’s applicable rules & procedures**.
