

BANGKOK TRAVEL ADVISORY

The Department of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, would like to inform that effective from 1 June 2022, Thailand's entry schemes will be adjusted, with details as follows;

- **Thai nationals (holders of Thai passports) are no longer required to register on Thailand Pass** and may travel to Thailand without having to undergo quarantine or COVID-19 tests. However, it is advised that Thai nationals should bring their certificate of vaccination (paper or digital form) or COVID-19 test result (if any).
- **Foreign nationals (holders of foreign passports) are required to register on Thailand Pass.** Thus, airlines are requested not to permit boarding to any foreign national traveling to Thailand without Thailand Pass. The entry schemes for foreign nationals are as follows;
 - **Fully Vaccinated Persons must :**
 - Register on Thailand Pass
 - Attach passport and certificate of vaccination
 - Attach proof of insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatment in Thailand
 - **Unvaccinated / Not Fully Vaccinated Persons must :**
 - Register on Thailand Pass
 - Attach passport and COVID-19 RT-PCR / Professional ATK (self-ATK not permitted) test result issued within 72 hours before traveling (must attach on Thailand Pass only)
 - Attach proof of insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatment in Thailand

Please Note:

- All travelers whose Thailand Pass have already been issued, can travel with the issued QR Code and do not need to register for new Thailand Pass.
- **Airlines are requested to check the Thailand Pass QR Code of foreign nationals** traveling to Thailand, and to ensure that the required documents, namely the certificate of vaccination / COVID-19 test result, are properly attached therein. Once in Thailand, the Thailand Pass QR Code of foreign passengers will be checked again by the Thai disease control officers upon arrival.
- Unvaccinated / not fully vaccinated foreign nationals **can also use a COVID-19 Professional ATK** (self-ATK not permitted) test result issued within 72 hours before traveling to Thailand.
- All foreign nationals entering Thailand must attach in their Thailand Pass QR Code either a certificate of vaccination (for fully vaccinated persons) or COVID-19 RT-PCR / Professional ATK test result issued within 72 hours before traveling (for unvaccinated / not fully vaccinated persons).
